Networks for Integrating New Americans is a new, national initiative to advance immigrant integration. We will select up to five forward-thinking community networks (also coalitions or initiatives) to receive technical assistance to address the linguistic, civic, and economic needs of immigrant adults. Organizational networks are key to this project because when organizations in both immigrant and receiving communities collaborate on immigrant integration, both communities contribute unique strengths and better address common needs.

What Opportunities Does Participation Provide?

The initiative offers an opportunity for an existing network to receive sustained technical assistance (TA) from nationally recognized experts:

- Strengthen your efforts that enable immigrants to effectively integrate linguistically, economically, and civically.
- Build the capacity of your ESOL programs to carry out collaborative efforts that enhance the learning and life outcomes of adult students.
- Learn from others who are also working on immigrant integration in their communities.
- Gain national visibility for your local efforts.
- Increase opportunities for potential funding in the area of immigrant integration.
- Contribute to the knowledge base that will help other communities.
